Types of information we gather.

We gather Information You Give Us:

We receive and store any and all information you enter and/or provide to us on our Websites, emails, telephones, and mail or give us in any other way. You can choose not to provide certain information, but then you might not be able to take advantage of many of our features. We use the information that you provide to us for such purposes as account inquiries, order fulfillment, payment processing and responding to your requests and communicating with you.

Automatic Information Gathered:

What Are Cookies?
